


Click on “Keyword Search” or “Advanced Search” to get started.






In this "Advanced Search" I entered "Red Cloud" in the People field. And it yielded 88 entries with more direct association to the person, Chief Red Cloud.






This pectoral happens to be on exhibit currently, so you could come to the museum and take a picture of it there too - (without a flash, please :).
